



What is a Bequest?

A bequest is a gift made through your Will, and can be made in the form of specific dollar amounts, property, a percentage of your estate, or all or a portion of what remains after you have provided for your family.

To continue to support Burnie Brae after your lifetime, your Will must use the following wording:

I GIVE the sum of \$to Burnie Brae Ltd ("the Company") for any one or more of the objects of the Company and I declare that the receipt of the said Company shall be a full and complete discharge to my Trustee. My Trustee will not be bound to see to the application of this bequest.
