Private Functions

Main hall only \$65/hour

BOND per event

Minimum \$1,000

Applies to some hires at the discretion of Burnie Brae \$2,000

Once the premises have been inspected after your event, your bond will be returned. You will receive the funds back into your nominated bank account (assigned in your contract) on the 15th or 30th of that month.

ACCESSIBILITY & PARKING

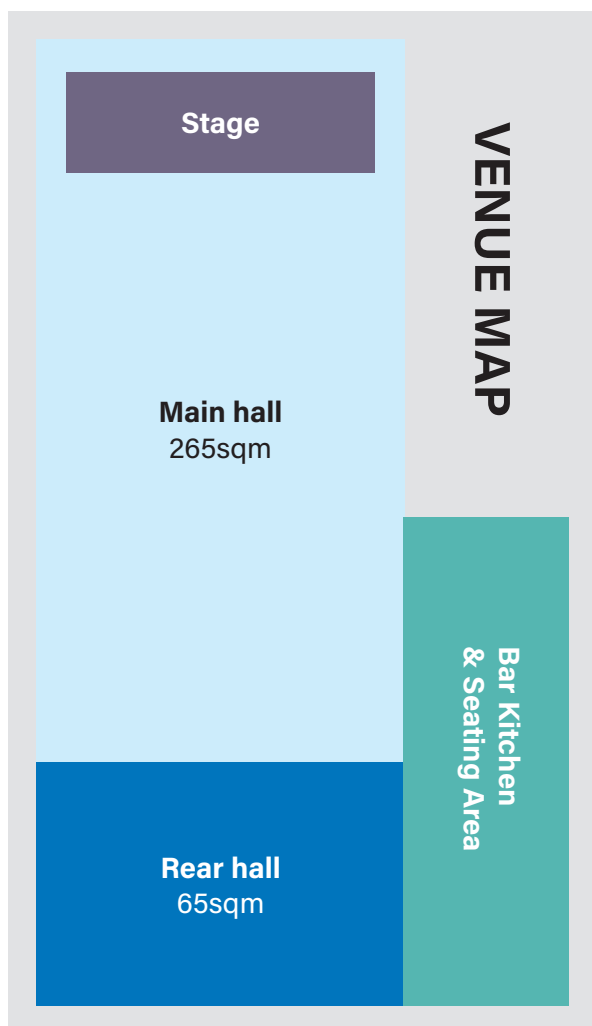
The centre is accessible from the car park (70 car spaces) and street parking (both street level) via pathway access.

SERVING OF ALCOHOL

If you are serving alcohol at your event, you must advise when booking. You are also required to submit a party safe registration with Queensland Police - www.police.qld.gov.au/initiatives/party-safe and provide your registration number to us prior to your booking confirmation.

If you are hiring the bar area, persons serving alcohol must hold a Responsible Service of Alcohol certification, which must be sighted prior to the event.

CATERING OPTIONS

The hall kitchen is only used for serving, not preparation. You will be required to hire or bring your own cutlery and crockery.

Hired caterers are required to view the premises prior to the event.

INSURANCE

Burnie Brae's public liability insurance only covers injury claims caused by the Burnie Brae building and facilities. We require all events that are not private functions to obtain adequate insurance of at least 20 million dollars for claims caused by your event preparations, decorations, attendees, activities or programs.

NOISE RESTRICTIONS

Music/noise must cease at 10pm, due to the hall proximity to residential housing.

PROHIBITED

- 18th and 21st celebrations
- Smoking in and within 5 meters of the building
- Open flames including, but not limited to candles, lanterns and smoke machines
- Decorations i.e. glitter, rice sand and confetti
- Affixing decorations that may cause damage i.e sticky tape, pins and tacks.

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
